Construction of a new tram power substation at St Kilda Road, St Kilda Junction will commence in mid-2017.

Upgrading substations is part of the Victorian Government's investment in new trams and modern infrastructure to boost capacity for the future demand of Melbourne's tram network.

Substations are common across the network and this one has been strategically placed to provide power to nearby Routes 3/3a, 5, 16, 64 and 67.

A Public Information Session will be held for residents, businesses and interested people to find out more about the new tram power substation.

The information session will provide you with an opportunity to learn more about the project and what the upgrade means for you both during the works and into the future. The community will also have an opportunity to provide feedback on the proposed architectural treatment for the substation.
